Siam Park is the largest water park in Europe and is located in Adeje on the southern coast of Tenerife. It is near the resorts at Costa Adeje, Playa de las Americas and Los Cristianos. The water park consists of several water rides, as well as an amphitheater and a sea lion pool - a great attraction for families wanting to entertain their children while on a holiday in Tenerife.
